For young musicians

Presentation of saxophone book "Progresive method for saxophone" (author Erik Rothenstein) and "Children songs" (contemporary slovak composers, collected by Erik Rothenstein)

The main idea is to support childrens musical abilities and skills and to introduce a complex system of practicing and teaching.

Workshop contains:

- technical part (exercises, warm up system, fingering, articulation, sound exercises, rhytmical exercises & scat)
- introducing children songs composed by contemporary slovak musicans and composers L'uboš Bernáth, L'uboš Šrámek, Nikolaj Nikitin, Viliam Gräffinger, Ester Wiesnerová, Erik Rothenstein. A method to start and improvisation and it practical use in music.

For advanced musicians

- -an advance concept for daily practice routine, scale and chord theory system and it practical use in improvisation
- -introducing original classical compositions and transcriptions (Debussy, Bach, Ravel, Slovak composers....), popular songs, jazz and discussion about connection various "music worlds" and traditions.

Workshop is addressed mainly for blowing but also all other instruments and teachers interested in practical system of supporting musical creativity.



Workshops started in 2015. Group Lento Ad Astra beside the workshop plays a concert connected with discussion about the compositions and composers.
